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-2- But at university and in my twenties I went to most countries in Europe, as well as to India and the USA. I'd go somewhere different each time, sometimes on my own, sometimes with a friend. And I wanted to learn as much about a place as possible -reading about it and doing a lot of sightseeing, so I'd really get a sense of people and the culture.

-3- Mostly I'd splash out on really nice holidays for a few nights. Egypt was particularly thrilling; because I'd seen so many pictures of the pyramids atschool, I almost couldn't believe I was really seeing them. We also stayed by the Red Sea, and then took trips to the desert -we even spent a night camping in the moonscape.

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-4- Istanbul, too, was stunning. All those clichés about how East meets West are true. I loved everything about it, and especially the souks. I hate shopping in England, but Istanbul, with its rugs and its jewelry, is different matter.


